SCRUM IN ONE SENTENCE



Lightweight framework based on empiricism and lean, to generate value through adaptive solutions for complex problems.

PILLAR5

TRANSPARENCY- A common understanding of processes and work being inspected for both the scrum team and stakeholders.

INSPECTION - The inspection of artifacts and the progress enabling adaptation, without which is pointless.

ADAPTATION - Adapting based on inspection to minimize deviations outside of acceptable limits.

TEAM

SCRUM MASTER - Leader, who serves the Scrum Team, and the organization by coaching in Scrum adoption, removing impediments, and facilitating activities.

PRODUCT OWNER - One person representing the stakeholder's needs, maximizing the value of the product according to the Product Goal.

DEVELOPERS- The creators of a usable Increment based on the Sprint Backlog and Sprint plan.

EVENTS

SPRINT- A container for all the events where the work is done, maximally one month long.

SPRINT PLANNING -Initiates the sprint by creating a plan for the sprint, deciding what can be done and how.

VALUES

FOCUS - Everyone focuses on the work of the Sprint and the goals of the Scrum Team.

RESPECT - Scrum Team members respect each other and the wider environment as the source of change.

OPENESS- The Scrum Team and its stakeholders agree to be open about all the work and the challenges involved.

ARTIFACTS

PRODUCT BACKLOG -

An ongoing ordered list reflecting a product goal and the only source of work.
